Day 1: Depart Home - Arrive Fairbanks

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Fairbanks. Upon arrival you'll be greeted and transferred to your hotel for a two night stay.

Overnight: Fairbanks

Day 2: Fairbanks

Today you'll enjoy a city tour of Fairbanks in a deluxe motorcoach. The tour includes a stop at the **Trans-Alaska Oil Pipeline** and gives you a great overview of the Fairbanks community. Enjoy a ride on the **Riverboat Discovery**, a three-hour journey that will take you into the heart of Alaska. Operated by a family who has made the Alaskan rivers home for five generations, you'll witness a Bush Pilot take off and land beside the boat, and hear stories of flying into remote Alaska firsthand. Halfway through the experience, you'll be immersed in frontier living with a guided walking tour of a recreated Athabaskan Indian village. See cabins made of spruce logs, along with other indigenous dwellings that have allowed the strong Athabaskan people to survive for thousands of years in this harsh environment.

Overnight: Fairbanks

Day 3: Fairbanks - Alaska Rail Road - Denali

This morning, enjoy traveling along the rails of the **Alaska Railroad** to **Denali National Park**. As you travel through the high tundra plateau into the Healy Gorge and Canyon, be watchful for wildlife during your rail journey. This Afternoon enjoy a **Natural History Tour**, watch for ptarmigan, Alaska's state bird, in the open valleys and golden eagles patrolling the higher elevations. Keep your eyes open for moose, bear, caribou and hopefully, enjoy a view of Mt. McKinley. This evening enjoy leisure time to relax or explore on your own. There are optional excursions available such as river rafting or helicopter flightseeing.

Overnight: Denali

Day 4: Denali - Anchorage - Seward/Board Ship

This morning depart Denali by deluxe motorcoach for a brief city tour in Anchorage. Then continue south down the "All American Scenic Highway" to historic Seward to begin your 7-night cruise aboard the elegant **Norwegian Sun**. Onboard amenities include a Las Vegas style casino, movie theatre, pools and a library. While onboard, enjoy breakfast, lunch and fine dinners daily, as well as nightly entertainment in the Theater.

Meal - (D) Overnight: Norwegian Jewel

Day 5: Cruising - Hubbard Glacier

This "Galoping Glacier" made history in 1986 when it surged forward at a rate of up to 130 feet a day, blocking off Russell Fjord. The ice dam was eventually broken, but Hubbard Glacier continues to surge forward, carving icebergs into the water. Keep your binoculars handy as you cruise through the glacier's home waters--the wildlife-rich Yakutat Bay.

Meals - (B,L,D) Overnight: Norwegian Jewel

Day 6: Cruising - Icy Strait Point

If it's tranquility and nature you seek, Icy Strait Point is your destination. Hosting only "one ship at a time," Icy Strait Point is located fifty miles west of Juneau and at the mouth of Glacier Bay. Travelers have the opportunity to experience Tlingit culture, superior wildlife viewing and Alaskan history.

Meals - (B,L,D) Overnight: Norwegian Jewel

Day 7: Cruising - Juneau - Sawyer Glacier

Today the ship arrives in Alaska's capital, Juneau, nestled between mountains and sea with a rustic charm that's both cosmopolitan & frontier. Maybe visit the Alaska State Museum to see a native clan house and a birch-bark canoe, gold rush memorabilia and Russian Orthodox relics. A short drive out of Juneau takes you to the impressive Mendenhall Glacier.

Meals - (B,L,D) Overnight: Norwegian Jewel

Day 8: Cruising - Skagway

The frontier spirit is alive and well in the gold-rush town of Skagway, the northernmost point of Alaska's Inside Passage. Relive the city's past in lively saloons, rousing dance hall revues and on vintage street car tours. Maybe board the historic White Pass & Yukon Railway or take the Klondike Summit drive to pan for gold.

Meals - (B,L,D) Overnight: Norwegian Jewel

Day 9: Cruising - Ketchikan

Today visit Ketchikan, "Salmon Capital of the World" and ancestral home of the Tlingit Indians. The rustic waterfront village has the world's largest collection of totem poles. Maybe learn the meaning behind totem pole imagery at the Saxman Native Village.

Meals - (B,L,D) Overnight: Norwegian Jewel

Day 10: Cruising - Inside Passage

Threading along the scenic coast of Canada and Alaska, the Inside Passage offers spectacular close-up views of rain forests, sparkling glaciers, steep-walled fjords and snow-capped mountains. Watch closely for whale, sea lion, bear and other wildlife as the Inside Passage is home to more than 100 species of animals.

Day 11: Vancouver, B.C. - Depart for home
